Discipline Policies

A. The Club will follow the Discipline By Review process for all cases as outlined in OSA Published Rules. In some cases a Hearing will be required and as such the appropriate parties will be notified. A detailed explanation of the DBR, DBH and Special Incident Report systems are included in the Coaches package.

B. The player has a right to request a hearing (DBH). The request for a hearing (in writing) must be received no later than 72 hours from the date of the game.

C. The Club will follow OSA Standard Penalties for Misconduct. This can be found in the Coaches Package and OSA website www.soccer.on.ca (Published Rules – Discipline).

D. Failure to appear for a hearing will result in an immediate suspension from All Soccer Activities. The accused must then request a discipline hearing in writing.

E. All suspensions will begin after notification from the Club.

F. Any player or team official listed on a game sheet is deemed to have participated in that game. Players or team officials participating in a game while under suspension will be subject to disciplinary action which could include forfeiture of game.

G. A team using a player in a game that is not listed on the game sheet will be subject to disciplinary action which will include forfeiture of the game.
