DISCIPLINE

Players or officials reported for misconduct shall be dealt with by the Discipline Committee of the East York Soccer Club. Standard Discipline By Review (DBR) will be applied, unless the Discipline Committee deems a Hearing to be warranted or a player requests a hearing, in writing, within 72 hours of completion of the game. The Discipline Committee shall consist of an elected Chairman (Vice President of the Club) and any two members of the executive. In all cases of alleged physical assault on game officials the party/parties concerned will stand suspended until the incident has been dealt with by The Scarborough Soccer Association.

OSA STANDARD PENALTIES

Mandatory player suspensions for misconduct by a player for all games played in the East York Soccer Club House League.

1.16	Dismissed for "Using offensive, insulting or abusive language and/or gestures directed at the game official(s).	3 games
1.17	Dismissed for "Denying an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball".	1 game
1.18	Dismissed for "Denying an opponent a goal or an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the player's goal, by an offence punishable by a free kick or penalty kick".	2 games
