

EAST YORK SOCCER CLUB – Rule of 2

This Rule means that the coach is NEVER alone or out of sight with a child (who is not his/her own).

All one-on-one interactions between a coach and a player must take place within earshot and in view of the second coach, and/or Parents/Guardians, except for medical emergencies.

Two coaches, and/or Parents/Guardians should always be present with a player who is a minor, when in a potentially vulnerable situation such as in a locker room or meeting room.
